

# NVQ Childrens Care Learning and Development Level 4

This NVQ is designed for people who work as centre managers, senior practitioners, childminding co-ordinators or pre-school advisers.

Candidates completing this NVQ may wish to progress to further qualifications at level 4 in the same and related subject areas, including NVQ Leadership and Management for Care Services Level 4.

To achieve the level 4 qualification learners will need to complete nine units, the following four of which is mandatory:

- CCLD 401 Establish and develop working relationships
- CCLD 402 Support policies, procedures and practice to safeguard children and ensure their inclusion and well-being
- CCLD 403 Support programmes for the promotion of children's development
- CCLD 404 Reflect on, review and develop own practice

The optional units available are as follows and there are many more available:

- CCLD 405 Co-ordinate provision of babies and children under 3 years in partnership with their families
- CCLD 406 Develop and support children's early learning in partnership with teachers
- CCLD 407 Support and evaluate the curriculum for children's early learning
- CCLD 409 Evaluate, assess and support children's communication
- CCLD 410 Evaluate, assess and support children's creativity

- CCLD 413 Develop and implement operational plans for your area of responsibility
- CCLD 414 Co-ordinate and support provision for disabled children and those with special educational needs
- CCLD 416 Establish and sustain relationships with providers of services to children and families

Assessments will take place in the workplace and will include the following methods: Observation, professional discussion, questioning, and projects and assignments.
